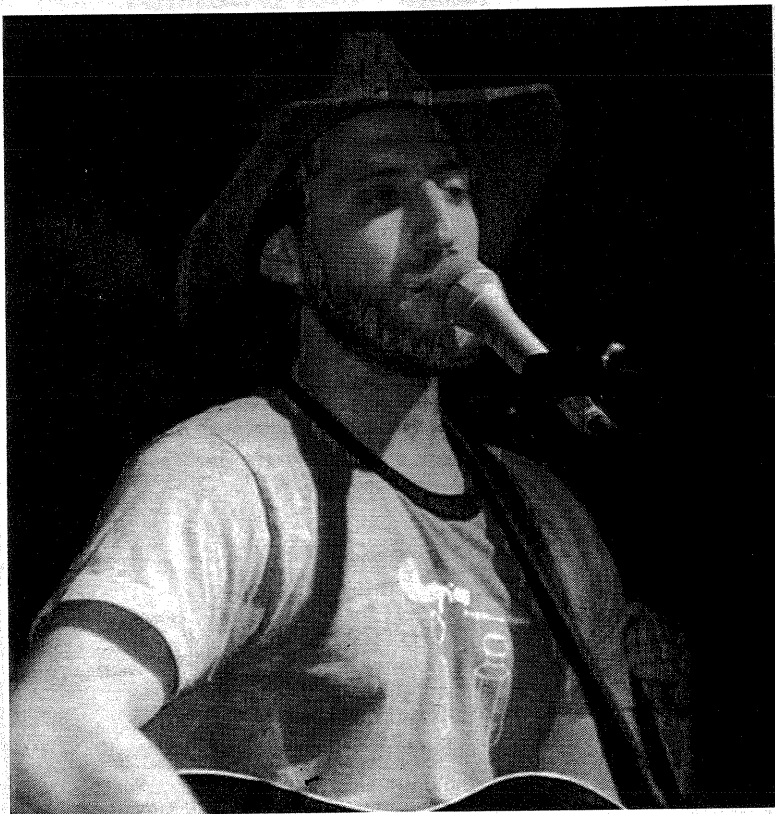


Todd Adelman & The Love Handles
